Shipbuilding era honoured

GLASGOW'S shipbuilding past has been honoured.

Tom McKendrick has depicted HMS Ramillies in a sculpture seven feet high and 21 feet long. The ship was built in 1916 by Beardmore's in Dalmuir.

This week, the model was galvanised by Cumbernauld firm Highland, and will go on display at the entrance to the old shipyard.

It was commissioned by Dalmuir Park Housing Association. Mr McKendrick - born in Clydebank - said: "I've thoroughly enjoyed it."
